Bruno Dubois is Professor of Neurology at the Neurological Institute of the University Salpêtrière Hospital in Paris. He is Director of the “Institute for Memory and Alzheimer Disease” (IM2A) and of the Research INSERM Unit on “Cognition, Neuro-imagery and Brain diseases” at the ICM (Institut du Cerveau et de la Moelle Epinière). He leads the Center of Excellence in Neurodegenerative Disorders (CoEN) of Paris and the National reference Centres for “Rare Dementias” and for “Young-Onset Alzheimer’s disease”

He has published more than 450 scientific articles on anatomical and biochemical studies on the central cholinergic systems in rodents and humans, on cognitive neuropharmacology, and on neuropsychology in patients with frontal lobe dysfunction and with dementia. He recently leads the International Working Group on the New Criteria for Alzheimer’s disease.
